





A NEW SAFETY STANDARD WILL GO INTO EFFECT ON JUNE 1, 2024

The American National Standards Institute (ANSI) will require the vast majority of all window covering products sold in the US to be cordless or to have inaccessible or short cords.

The revised updated safety standard, ANSI/WCMA A100.1-2002, strengthens window covering safety by eliminating the use of free hanging operating cords, free hanging tilt cords and multiple cord connectors on all made-to-order custom window covering products.

The compliance date for the new standard for all companies manufacturing, distributing or selling window covering products in the US is June 1, 2024.
