A current challenge

With over 400,000 domestically owned federal facilities averaging 47 years old [1], the *estimated deferred maintenance and repair (DM&R)* exceeds \$1T and compounds at 7% annually [2]. Businesses also face capacity loss and increased operational costs due to challenges such as a tough US labor market, shrinking maintenance windows, and siloed data sources.

What is Predictive Maintenance (PdM)?

PdM monitors and diagnoses systems and equipment, predicting failures before they occur and providing asset owners with transparency into their assets' current state.


